Services will be held immediately following with burial at Odd Fellows Cemetary in Camden DE. In lieu of flowers, donations may be made to your local SPCA.




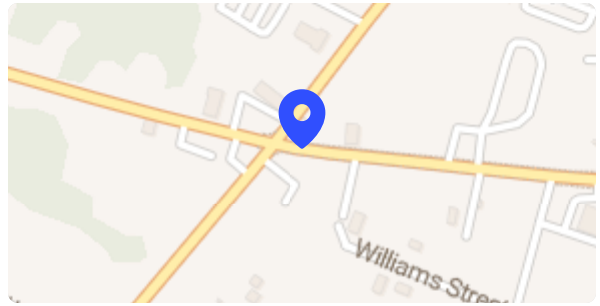
